STEAM MILL POWERS DOWN FOR WINTER

VISITORS to a historic mill took a step back in time to find out how it worked, on the last day it opens to the public for the year.

Sunday was the last 'steam day' at Grade II-listed Combe Steam Mill, near Woodstock,

originally built to provide power for Blenheim Palace.

The open day gave visitors a look at the work needed to keep the mill going, and Combe Mill Society volunteers, including Chris Hayes — pictured with his

improvised syrup tin oilcan — were on hand to answer questions.

There were also demonstrations of traditional crafts at the blacksmith's forge and displays of wood turning.

The mill normally opens for just four days a year, but that was increased this year to eight.

The society eventually hopes to open the mill all-year round.
